

All agreed that the proposal from HAGS should be accepted as it offered the most items and covered the widest age range, whilst including the items deemed as most wanted.

Members also considered quotes for solar lighting. There were concerns that the poles were too small although higher ones may require planning permission. Members liked the multi directional options and agreed that a timer would be preferable to a motion sensor which may disturb residents. Members also wanted to know the cost of replacement parts and if any protective cage could be fitted to prevent vandalism. It was agreed that officers would investigate these issues and that delegated authority be given to the Chairman of the Committee, the next leader and the next mayor to select the light.
